CALC Programs

Door A

- Area Learning Center – a high school alternative education program for qualifying students in grades 8-12 (day and after school programs)

Door B

- Journey Transition – an independent living skills program for special education students with unique needs and abilities who are between 18 and 21 years of age.

Door C

- ACE (Adult Continuing Education) – an adult basic education/GED (General Educational Development Diploma) preparation and basic skills development.
- Adult Transition – a diploma program focusing on credit and the five transition skills for special education students whose class graduated and are 18 and 21 years of age.

Facility

The CALC building has three entries:

- Door A for the Area Learning Center program. Includes 21 classrooms and offices spaces, a science lab, art room and computer lab.
- Door B for Journey Program-Special Projects. Includes one classroom and a recreation/physical education area.
- Door C for the Adult Transition program, and ACE. Includes 13 classrooms and office spaces.

CALC has three parking lots:
