Billing Information: Payments are due by the 23rd of each month. You will receive your bill at the beginning of each month in your parent file at the site. Accounts not paid on time will be assessed a \$20 late fee. For those who use bill pay, please adjust your automatic payment date to be earlier in order to help alleviate the possibility of a late charge.

Late Start: On Friday, Feb. 10, there is a two-hour late start for grades 1 - 12. Kindergarten and KC Preschool will start at their normal times. Watch for registration forms the week after winter break.
